Anticipated Fees and Expenses

EGG DONOR FEE:

\$6,000+* (Depending on needed ethnic background, geographical location, experience, education, and resulting pregnancies from past donations.)

\$8,000+ For special request/"Exceptional Donors"[™]. (i.e. Ivy league educated, college educated, proven intelligence, etc) (The average fee for a first time, Exceptional Donor is about \$8,000)

AGENCY FEES:

Donors who have completed 0-2 cycles

\$4000 if the donor is local to your medical facility and can attend all appointments there.

\$4500 if the donor is not local to your clinic, requiring her to have any satellite monitoring at a facility near her.

Donors who have completed 3+ cycles

\$5000 if the donor is local to your medical facility and can attend all appointments there.

\$5500 if the donor is not local to your clinic, requiring her to have any satellite monitoring at a facility near her.

The agency fee is paid in Two (2) equal installments.

1. **\$25.00** for up to three (3) donor profile. This fee covers time and expense incurred by Fertility Alternatives, Inc. \$25 profiles fee will be applied to the final installment of the agency fee if you choose to move forward with a donor in the program.
2. The first installment of the Agency fee is payable upon choosing a donor, at which time the Agreement for Services is signed and Trust Account will also be funded in the amount of \$2500.
3. The final installment of the Agency fee is due when the Egg Donor Agreement is signed by the Parties

Trust Account: (Required)

No Charge to pay Egg Donors fee and other basic fees from Trust account. (Bank fees and check charges may apply.)

For screening and cycle expenses, the Trust Account is to be funded in three installments,

based on the agency's written estimate of expense. The First installment of \$2500 will be due at the time of contracting with the Agency. These funds will be used to pay for any required donor medical or psychological screening not performed at your IVF clinic, travel for screening, and/or to cover actual cycle expenses that go above and beyond what was accounted for in the original estimate of expenses.

The Second installment will be due upon the signing of the Egg Donor agreement between the egg donor and the Intended Parents. The final installment will be due prior to the day the Donor administers injectable medications.

Any remaining balance left in the Trust Account after all bills have been paid will be returned to the Intended Parents.

International Clients: \$750.00

Administrative fee per Egg Donor cycle. This fee can be waived if all communications can be handled by email.

Health Insurance Policy: \$345.00-\$500.00

This fee will be added to the Trust Account and included in the estimate of expenses. Fertility Alternatives, Inc. provides mandatory blanket egg donor/recipient accident insurance policy. Premium: \$400 or \$245(for donor only) and Administrative fee: \$100. This covers the donor, recipient, and the paperwork involved, and will be paid directly from the Trust account to Brown and Brown of TX. (If your clinic provides egg donor insurance, Fertility Alternatives, Inc., is required to take precedence over the clinic to provide such coverage.)

PROFESSIONAL FEES AND EXPENSES

Psychological Screening: up to **\$600.00** for initial screening. (Any special requests such as I.Q testing will be additional.) Some Egg Donors have already had a psychological screening, in which case another may not be necessary. *This will be paid from the Trust Account.*

Medical Screening: **\$800-\$2000** for blood work, labs, ultrasounds, and office visits as required by the main clinic for Egg Donor and partner screening. (Any special requests such as genetic testing will be additional.)* *If your IVF clinic provides this screening, you will pay your clinic directly for these costs. If screening is provided by a different facility, costs will be paid from the Trust Account.*

Donor Medications:

Agency does not handle medication coordination or payment.

Attorneys' Fees: *Egg donor's attorney's fee will range \$300-\$600*

\$800-\$1200 for Egg Donor and Recipients.*

Recipients will need to retain their own attorney specializing in Egg Donation for purposes of drafting the Egg Donor Contract. Referrals will be provided if necessary.

TRAVEL EXPENSES: (approximate) For Donor and Companion for Egg retrieval.

\$250-\$800+ Flights per traveler

\$89-\$160 hotel per night

\$55 meal allowance per day per traveler.

\$20 phone and entertainment per day for donor retrieval week.

\$400 Rental car/ transportation allowance

\$300 Misc. expense (Airport parking/shuttle, rental car fuel, etc)

\$.52 per mile for long distance driving.

\$5000 or less approximately.

Donor may also have to travel for screening up to approximately \$1000.

A more accurate estimate of expenses will be provided for your individual case.

Additional Expenses: Intended Parents shall be responsible for all expenses incurred by the egg donor on behalf of the egg donation process. (i.e. medications, medical, laboratory, psychological, escrow/trust account, and attorney's fees, insurance co-payments or deductibles, etc.)

The Agency will not pay any donor expenses upfront, on behalf of the Intended Parents.

Should egg donor have to travel, all travel, lodging, meal allowance set by the Agency, childcare or Lost wages for the Egg Donor and a companion (actual travel expenses for companion only) will be the responsibility of the Intended Parents and is industry standard. Travel meal and expense allowances are non-negotiable.

Other expenses may arise such as egg donor's lost wages (actual net lost wages, not to exceed \$100 per day for retrieval, reasonable recovery period and/or retrieval travel), childcare, excessive mileage, and medical attention due to Ovarian Hyperstimulation Syndrome, etc. Documentation will be required of the Egg Donor.

Each Egg Donor has her own individual circumstances that may cause additional expense or a higher fee. The final result will be determined after negotiations by all Parties, their attorneys, and Fertility Alternatives, Inc.

Additional expenses such as postage, wire and/or bank fees.

Professionals' Fees stated above, are only an average. Some professionals' fees may be higher or lower. Actual fees charged by professionals can be determined by contacting them directly. (IVF costs are not included in this fee schedule.)

Disclaimer: Fertility Alternatives, Inc. can only make a rough estimate of the costs involved in a Donor arrangement. The Donor's individual requests, circumstances, and each individual professional fee, may drastically change the financial outcome originally anticipated in a Donor arrangement. This fee schedule can only give you a better idea of what to expect.

FEES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE
